

Instruction Sheet for Bedbug Service.

ALL PESTICIDES WILL BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURERS LABEL

Take Note: For best results follow all recommendations given verbally and written, before, during, and after treatment, by service professionals.

Before:

1. With extreme care, gently remove all bed covers, bed sheets, pillowcases, mattress covers and launder with detergent in hot water. Dry in high heat.
2. Place in an airtight bag. (Twist plastic bag until making a neck like top, and tightly create a noose)
3. Remove personal items from: beneath bed, closets, cabinets, night- stands, dressers, and storage boxes. Carefully inspect these items to make sure they are bedbug free. If possible, launder in high heat, steam, or thoroughly wash items then place in airtight bag. Properly seal bag as noted in line #2
4. Keep laundered items separate from unlaundered items.
5. Keep separate bags for clothes that will be used during the time frame of treatment program. Bags for unlaundered clothes, and bags for laundered clothes. Cycle through clothes after every wash and reseal bags.
6. Place bags in the center of room, or in areas that will not be treated, like bathtubs, kitchen, dining area. Away from carpet.

7. **Do not apply personal pesticide products before, during or after pest control professional treatment. This may compromise treatment, delay control of bedbugs and incur additional cost.**
8. All electrical outlet cover should be removed from bedrooms, living room, and all affected areas. (This should be done before initial treatment. Customer/ Tenant responsible for reinstalling electrical outlet covers back on.)
9. **Pets should be removed for a minimum of 4 hours. All aviary and reptile pets must be removed for a minimum of 24 hours, and aquariums must be sealed off with plastic covering and filters turned off and remain off for 4 hours after treatment.**
10. **All persons must vacate the premises for a minimum of 4 hours. Any persons with ailing health, pregnancy, or infants must vacate for 24 hours and or following doctors' advice.**
11. **Do not vacuum. This may spread adults and eggs to other un-affected areas.**

After:

1. Upon returning to the premises, open windows for a short period of time. Thoroughly ventilating treated areas following application can reduce potential odors.
2. Turn aquarium filter back on and remove plastic covering.
3. **Follow all recommendations left behind on "Bedbug Report," left inside the unit, or with Manager of building.**
4. **On "Final Follow Up" please make sure Bedbug bed covers are left unopened, in original packaging inside of unit, or with manager. California Shores CalSho will install bed Bedbug covers upon prior agreement.**
